He is a Digital Intelligence Systems Master Gunner (DISMG) and spearheaded the creation of the Digital Intelligence Integration Working Group (DIIWG) in the 66th Military Intelligence Brigade (Theater) which helps create common understanding of intelligence workflows throughout the European Theater; while working on modernizing systems and process to better enable the Intelligence Process and partner sharing.

CW2 Seamon's proficiency in digital intelligence architecture has been instrumental in streamlining processes and enhancing mission planning. Currently he is leading the Army in the implementation and training of the Army Intelligence Data Platform (AIDP) which is the replacement of the old intelligence POR. He previously incorporated new Programs of Record including Capability Drop 1 (CD-1) Battalion Solution into new and existing intelligence architecture.

Since June 2021, CW2 Seamon has been serving in the 66th Military Intelligence Brigade (Theater) as a 350F Intelligence Analysis Technician. He continues to excel in his role, sourcing, assessing, and disseminating data-driven intelligence products that enhance combat effectiveness. Previously served as the BISE Chief (2018-2020) in 1st Brigade of the 82nd Airborne Division and Division and FUSION OIC (2020-2021) at 82nd Airborne Division. His expertise in digital intelligence architecture and his ability to incorporate new technologies and solutions have streamlined processes and improved mission planning within his organization
