WARRANT OFFICER ONE JAMES ANDERSON

Warrant Officer One James Anderson is a Technical Integrator and Advisor for the 691st Cyberspace Operations Squadron, Ramstein Air Base, Germany. In this capacity, he engineers system fix-actions, cybersecurity training, and evaluates offensive and defensive communications capabilities for the Cyber Security and Control Weapons Systems supporting United States Air Forces in Europe – Air Forces Africa. He provides technical counsel and guidance to 163 operators across five central cyber operator roles, advancing 688th Cyberspace Wing objectives in support of 11 Combatant Commands, six bases, and 121 Geographically Separate Units.

Warrant Anderson enlisted in the Air Force in November 2015 from Fayetteville, North Carolina. He graduated from the Cyber Transport Systems Journeyman Course at Keesler Air Force Base, Mississippi, in July of 2016 and earned a commission in June 2025. He began his career at Aviano Air Base, Italy, as a Network Manager for the 31st Communications Squadron, managing the base network and its associated Geographically Separate Units. While stationed at U.S. Army Garrison (USAG) Yongsan-Casey, South Korea, he established a Special Access Liaison position and served as the Authorized Service Interruption Coordinator for U.S. Forces Korea to align network and communication devices and configurations in preparation for the opening of USAG Camp Humphreys. Additionally, Warrant Anderson was assigned to the Secure Communications shop at Osan Air Base, performing crypto maintenance and secure phone installations. His efforts led to his deployment to Al Udeid, Qatar, where he served as Chief Watch Officer and Client Systems Technician, safeguarding the theater and its allies' cyberspace domain. Prior to his commission, Warrant Anderson served as Information Technology Project Manager, Quality Assurance Evaluator, and Operations Non-Commissioned Officer in Charge at Camp Zama, Japan, for the US Army, maintaining long-haul communications and power for US Army Japan.
